The Province has implemented a vaccine requirement for individuals entering recreation facilities,

50% capacity limits are now in place

QR Code with Physical Government ID required

No food or drink allowed at indoor sports events

Effective January 4, 2022, the use of the enhanced COVID-19 vaccine certificate with QR code and the Verify Ontario app will be required where proof of vaccination is required.
